Private care managers provide consultations to people and their families who are living at home and experiencing difficulties managing daily activities due to illness or disability.

Care managers can help develop a plan or arrange services such as caregivers, guardians, housing or legal assistance.

Care managers who are nurses can also provide medical evaluations and manage care.

Other care managers have Master's degrees in gerontology, social work, nursing or counseling.

Expect to pay \$85-\$300 per hour for care management services.


